

Co-Creation Factsheet: Bringing science and practice together to encourage the adoption of agroforestry - Knowledge base and transfer (June 2025)

What was/will be produced

- Description and baseline information for a network of agroforestry Living Labs across eight European countries, as innovation communities for co-design and knowledge exchange.
- An agroforestry Knowledge Hub integrated into the stakeholder engagement platform, serving as a repository of resources aimed at agroforestry practitioners.
- The creation of an agroforestry knowledge typology and knowledge gap analysis, informing the approach to decision support.
- An agroforestry decision support toolkit, making accessible to agroforesters a range of tools, models and other resources that can guide decision making.

How?

- Living Lab kick off meeting (online) and planning sessions within Reforest face-to-face project meetings in Barcelona and Brno
- Multiple meetings of the EMEA and ORC teams to progress the design and population of the Knowledge Hub
- Consultation with all Reforest partners on Knowledge Hub content
- Reforest Partner meetings to discuss the development of a decision support toolkit
- Interaction within the Training and Upskilling Farmers working group, including two meetings of Working Group members and subsequent follow-up between EMEA and ORC
- Interviews and follow-up consultation with agroforesters in the Living Labs to develop and refine the case studies for publication
- Interviews with farmers and other stakeholders to inform the knowledge gap analysis
- Meetings with representatives of DigitAF to ensure complementarity of approaches
- Writing of the associated project deliverables and milestones with quality assurance provided by the Reforest executive committee.
